



### **COUNSELING INTERNSHIP**

This is a hands-on internship from September 1st - May 31st where interns will have the opportunity to counsel students one-on-one, interact with parents and help develop and teach students Biblical ways of interacting and perceiving their world. Although this is an opportunity to work with children grades K-12, interns do not have to be passionate about working with children, they simply need to be passionate about seeing God change hearts through Biblical Counseling.

### **TIME COMMITMENT**

6-12 hours week

### **LOCATION**

Interns will be assigned to one or two of our 4 school campuses

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Counsel one-on-one with students
- Be accessible for consultations with teachers/principal/others
- Meet with Intern Coordinator for supervision once a week
- Help create material for guidance class (5th-8th grade) and help teach classes throughout the year
- Interact with counselee's parents, updating them on progress, concerns and making recommendations.

### **ADDITIONAL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED**

- Academic transcript through winter term in the current academic year (unofficial is fine)
- Letter of reference from your pastor focusing on your character, gifting for counseling related ministry, strengths and weaknesses.
- Letter of reference/support from your spouse (if married) or a close friend (if single) focusing on your character, gifting for counseling related ministry, ability to balance priorities, time availability for the internship, strengths and weaknesses.

### **NOTE**

This is an unpaid internship. There are limited expenses for interns. One requirement is to get all of your PA clearances, which will cost around \$40. You will also be responsible for your own transportation to and from campuses.
