

Third Grade School Supply List

Here are the things you will need to bring on the first day of school. Please follow all specifications so that these items are uniform.

- 1 large 3-ring binder that is covered in fabric and zips closed. Extra pockets on the front and inside are needed. (*Mead* and *Fivestar* brands hold up and work well.) The extra-large size with shoulder strap is TOO BIG. These need to fit in our chair pockets.
- Package of 5 (at least) plastic binder dividers with pockets
- Bible – NIV translation (We will use the New International Reader's Version in class. This version has large print and kid-friendly text.)
- 2 packs of 200 count WIDE ruled notebook paper
- 1 large glue stick (small size breaks & dries out quickly)
- 2 RED pens
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- Each of the following:
 - Crayola colored pencils – 12 or 24 count
 - Crayola colored washable markers – wide or fine tip
 - Crayola crayons – 16 count
- 3 large PINK erasers
- 48 good quality #2 yellow pencils – preferably sharpened
- 4 composition notebooks

- Sturdy (quality plastic holds up best) folders in the following colors, one of each color. These folders must be pronged and have pockets at the bottom. Please, no folders with writing, designs, or pictures!
 - Blue
 - Black
 - Green
 - Red
 - Orange
 - Purple
 - Yellow
 - White or clear

- Pack of 3 large boxes of tissues (you are always welcome to bring more...we always need tissues!)

- One 5 ½ X 8 plastic pencil box (larger size does not fit in desk)

- 9 X 12 clipboard

- Small pack (3-4) wide Expo dry erase markers

- 1 clean sock or whiteboard eraser

- 1 box of Ziploc Storage Bags
 - Boys bring gallon size
 - Girls bring quart size

- 2-3 bottles of hand sanitizer, preferably larger than pocket size

- Pack of disinfectant wipes, Clorox or similar

Many of the above items will be shared by the students. There is no need to put the student's name on anything. They will be given name labels in school, if needed.
