education & pedagogy

Our pedagogical approach centers around outstanding and caring teachers, who nurture the four relationships of shalom - to God, self, others, and creation. Our elementary campuses implement the Responsive Classroom model, while our upper school utilizes the Love and Logic model. We emphasize personal responsibility, collective ownership, and nurturing a strengths-based approach.

Advanced students have a variety of personalized college credit options to pursue, and students needing extra help have access to after-school tutoring and one-on-one learning support. We also offer electives such as photography, drama, weightlifting, American Sign Language, music theory, advanced art classes, and SAT prep.

Sports and the arts are an integral part of our curriculum. We believe the arts teach students to think more creatively and become more inquisitive, imaginative, and engaged learners. The City School also offers students the opportunity to participate in the following sports: basketball, soccer, track and field, cross country, girls volleyball, and bowling.
